

Player of the Year Points System

Player of the Year Points are weighted more heavily by the significance of the tournament and the size of the field. The tournament order of significance is as follows:

- 1) Junior Tour Championship
 - 2) Junior PGA Championship
 - 3) 3 Day Series Events
 - 4) 2 Day Series Events
 - 5) Field size (41-50, 31-40, 21-30, 11-20, 5-10)
- Points are distributed between the Boys 16-18, Boys 13-15, Girls 13-18 and 9 Hole Divisions by order of score.
 - For Player of the Year points to be awarded within your respective Boys division, 5 Boys must participate. For Player of the Year points to be awarded within your respective Girls or 9 Hole Division, 2 juniors must participate. The more overall Boys, Girls or 9 Holes that play within your respective division, the more points will be awarded for that event.
 - Each individual event that makes up a series event is awarded points just like it is an 18 hole event during the season. To be eligible for series points, you must complete every hole in the series and turn in a scorecard for each tournament. If a junior participates in all events in a series, he/she will be eligible for points in each individual tournament that make up the series and the overall series too.
 - Juniors who win more than once on the Philadelphia Junior Tour will earn an additional 100 bonus points for each additional victory.
 - The top leaders of the Sam Penecale Scoring Average list will earn additional points for their position on the list at the end of the season.
