NEW JERSEY SECTION JUNIORS WIN THIRD ANNUAL JON M. PRITSCH CUP

The third annual Jon M. Pritsch Cup was held on Thursday August 20, 2009 at Galloway National Golf Club in Galloway, NJ. The Ryder Cup style event pits twelve juniors from the Philadelphia Section PGA against twelve juniors from the New Jersey Section PGA. Four boys each represent both the 16-18 age division and the 13-15 age division for each Section. The teams are rounded out by two junior girls and two captains' picks. Each group plays two individual matches, worth one point each, while simultaneously playing a four-ball match, also worth one point. There is a total of eighteen points up for grabs.

For the third consecutive year the juniors from the New Jersey Section PGA were able to take home the victory. Being the defending champions the New Jersey Section only needed nine of the eighteen points to retain the Cup and they hit that number exactly.

The Philadelphia Section juniors surged ahead in the early matches claiming a total of five of the first six points available. However, the New Jersey Section juniors had a clean sweep in the third group claiming both of the individual matches as well as the four-ball match. Both groups in the 13-15 age division split their matches with each Section earning one and a half points. With only the junior girls group to finish the Philadelphia Section held a slim 8-7 points lead, needing one and a half points to win the Cup for the first time. The girls from the New Jersey Section had other ideas. They managed to take one of the individual matches as well as the four-ball to earn two of the three points and give their team a nine point total.

The Jon M. Pritsch Cup rotates between both the New Jersey Section and Philadelphia Section. The 2010 edition of the Jon M. Pritsch Cup will be played in the New Jersey Section at a venue and date yet to be determined.

The Jon M. Pritsch Cup is played to honor the memory of Jon Pritsch who tragically passed away in May of 1991 at the age of 17. Before his passing, Pritsch was recognized as one of the top golfers in the nation. To date the Jon M. Pritsch Memorial Fund has raised over \$155,000 and given away 55 scholarships to juniors looking to pursue a career in a golf related field.
